- analyse combinations of processes and techniques for dispute-handling, conflict-management, and change-management that can address complex situations constructively;
- revise skills for *diagnosing* situations, *defining* process(es), and *preparing* participants;
- *practise* key preparation skills in small- and large-group exercises.

Participants are welcome to present their own [de-identified past-or-current] cases for discussion and analysis.

The training meets the Best Practice Standards developed by the Australian Association of Restorative Justice (AARJ) for training in Group Conference facilitation.
